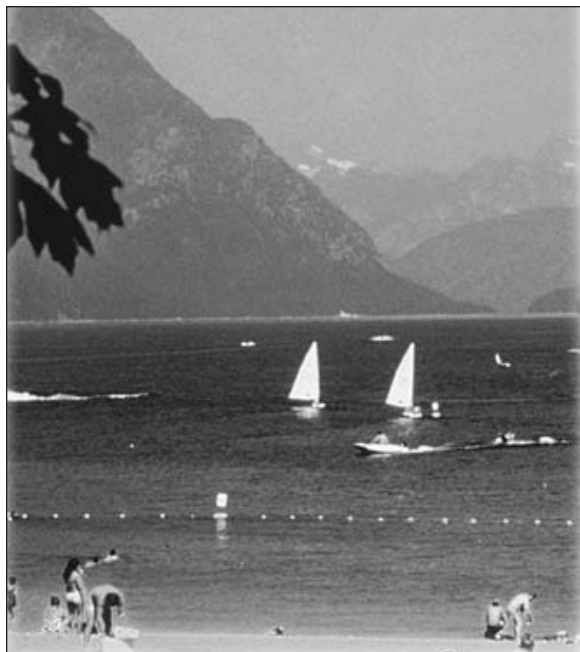

Camping in BC Parks

Making a Reservation

Now you can make your reservation online at www.discovercamping.ca, 7 days a week, or you can call the Discover Camping campground reservation service toll-free at 1-800-689-9025 (604-689-9025 in Greater Vancouver). Agents are available to take your reservation from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday to Friday and 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Saturday, Sunday and statutory holidays (Pacific Time), April 1 to September 15.

When making a reservation, you will be issued a reservation confirmation number. Please have this number available for any changes or cancellations, and on arrival at the campground.

Reservations can be made up to three months in advance and two days prior to your arrival date at the campground (five days prior to your arrival date at Birkenhead Lake, Liard River Hotsprings, Loveland Bay, Morton Lake, Stamp River and Strathcona [Buttle Lake]). Book early as many campgrounds fill up quickly. Reservable arrival dates vary from park to park, with the earliest date being April 1 and the latest being September 15.

The maximum length of stay in most provincial parks is 14 nights per park, per calendar year. Limits will be posted in the park.

Note: The maximum length of stay at Haynes Point Provincial Park is 7 days.

Fees

Reservation service and campsite fees must be paid in full, by VISA or MasterCard at the time of booking.

Additional fees for second vehicles (1/2 the campsite fee – see Party Size definition) must be paid in cash on arrival at the campground.

Reservation Service Fee

There is a non-refundable reservation service fee of \$6.30 per night, to a maximum of \$18.90 for three or more nights (includes 5% GST) per campsite. This fee covers the operational costs and ensures the reservation service pays for itself and is not subsidized by the taxpayers.

If you change or cancel your reservation, there is an additional non-refundable fee of \$6.30 (includes 5% GST) per campsite.

Campsite Fee

The nightly campsite fee is levied on a per party, per vehicle basis depending on the campground and the level of service provided.

Additional fees for second vehicles (1/2 the campsite fee – see Party Size definition) must be paid in cash on arrival at the campground.

Fees for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities

All reservation service fees apply for seniors and persons with disabilities.

If you reside in British Columbia, are 65 years or older and have a **BC PharmaCare** card, you may camp for half the full campsite fee before June 15 and after Labour Day. This discount applies to the senior and his/her spouse only.

If you reside in British Columbia and have been issued a:

- **Release of Information form** issued from the Ministry of Employment and Income Assistance confirming that you meet the criteria of the Persons with Disabilities under the “Employment and Assistance Program” OR
- **A Letter of Eligibility** stating that your child is eligible for the “At Home Program” issued by the Ministry of Children and Family Development,

you and your party may be exempt from campsite fees.

You must supply your **BC PharmaCare** card number or reference your **Release of Information Form/Letter of Eligibility** when making your reservation and present the applicable card/document on arrival at the campground. A second piece of identification is also required.

Note: Discounts do not apply to group picnicking, back country or marine park fees in provincial parks.

Changing a Reservation

If you wish to change your reservation, you must call the campground reservation service during business hours, 7:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday to Friday and 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Saturday, Sunday and statutory holidays (Pacific Time) **two days prior to your arrival date** at the campground (five days prior to your arrival date at Birkenhead Lake, Liard River Hotsprings, Loveland Bay, Morton Lake, Stamp River and Strathcona [Buttle Lake]).

Some parks have more than one campground and it is possible to change campgrounds within a park if space is available. You cannot, however, change your reservation from one park to another – this is considered a cancellation.

Long Weekends

If you are booking a campsite on a statutory long weekend, you will be required to reserve a designated minimum of three nights and all fees are non-refundable once on site.

Three-day long weekends are:

Victoria Day (May), BC Day (August) and Labour Day (September)

Canceling a Reservation

If you wish to cancel your reservation you can call Discover Camping at 1-800-689-9025 (Greater Vancouver 604-689-9025) 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

If you cancel your reservation, an additional non-refundable fee of \$6.30 (includes 5% GST) per campsite will apply. Note that for any cancellation, all reservation service fees are non-refundable.

If you cancel 7 or more days before your arrival date:

- ✦ You will be charged a cancellation fee of \$6.30 to cancel per campsite PLUS
- ✦ You will not be refunded change fees (if applicable) per campsite PLUS
- ✦ You will not be refunded your original reservation service fees of up to \$18.90 per campsite.

By cancelling, you could forfeit up to \$25.20 PER CAMPSITE (not including change fees).

If you cancel less than 7 days before your arrival date:

- ✦ You will be charged a cancellation fee of \$6.30 to cancel per campsite PLUS
- ✦ You will not be refunded change fees (if applicable) per campsite PLUS
- ✦ You will not be refunded your original reservation service fees of up to \$18.90 per campsite PLUS
- ✦ You will not be refunded one night of the campsite fee of up to \$24.00 per campsite.

By cancelling, you could forfeit up to \$49.20 PER CAMPSITE (not including change fees).

You have until 11:00 am the morning after your first reserved night to claim your campsite. If you do not cancel or arrive by the 11:00 am deadline, you are considered a no-show and there will be no refund.

Party Size for BC Parks

Due to wear and tear, maintenance and conservation factors within our parks, limits must be placed on the Party Size – the number of people and vehicles each campsite can accommodate.

In British Columbia provincial parks, a camping party is defined as follows:

- ✦ 1–4 persons 16 years of age or older.
- ✦ A maximum of 8 persons including children (15 years of age and younger).

Vehicles per camping party:

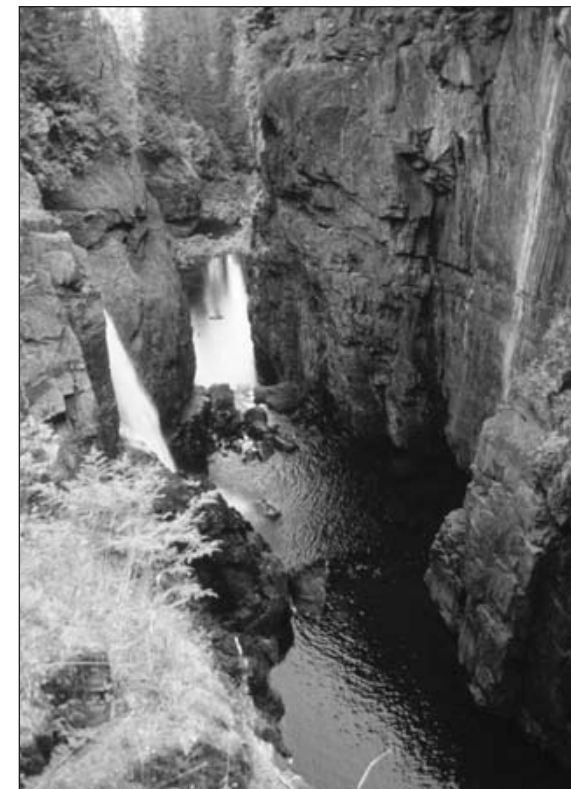
- ✦ One vehicle and trailer. Either one (but not both) may be an RV.
- ✦ A second vehicle (non-RV) may be allowed on site for an additional nightly charge of 1/2 the campsite fee. This additional 1/2 nightly fee is payable in cash, only on arrival at the campground.

Note: A towed vehicle is not considered a second vehicle.

Campsite Maximum:

- ✦ One camping party per site, unless otherwise authorized.

If you arrive at the park with more people or vehicles than you have reserved for, there may be an additional nightly campsite fee, or accommodations may not be available.

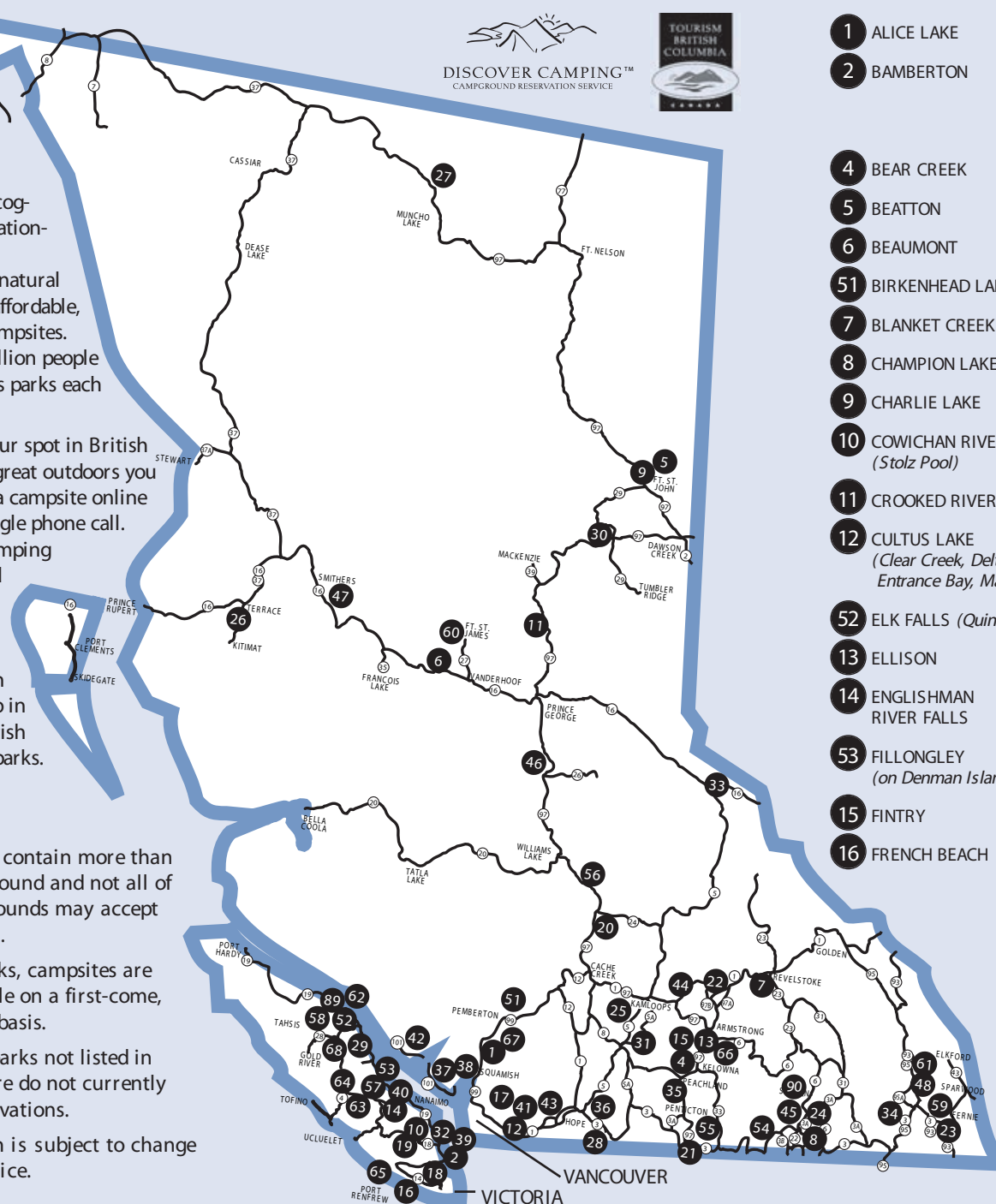
Note:
