Obey posted speed limits. They usually indicate animal crossing areas.

Pay special attention during dawn and dusk.

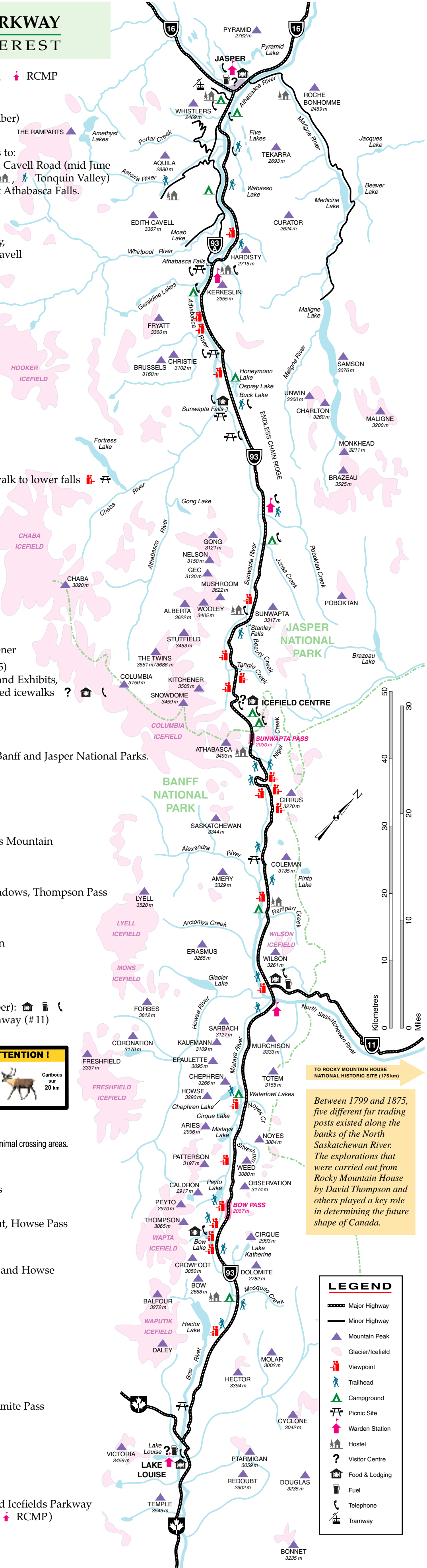
